I am investigating the sexualisation and objectification of female video game characters. This includes the way they are presented to the player and audience, as well as the elements of their appearance like costume design. Through my prior research, I found that female characters were designed to appeal to male players, who are the primary target audience of video games. I found many instances of male gamers reacting negatively to progressive and realistic depictions of women, and positively to more sexual and objectified designs. I will be investigating if this is still the case among players in 2024.

I will reassure participants that their answers will be strictly anonymous and will be stored on a password protected computer at all times. Once my research is complete, the information will be used to inform a university project. I may turn data into graphs to display it clearly for my project. There will be no questions that could be used to identify participants.

I will also ask that no one under the age of 18 participates in the survey. The characters will come from a variety of genres, but most will be from 18 rated games. The costumes will not show nudity, but may contain shirtless male characters, and female characters showing cleavage.

The survey will show many characters, both male and female, in a variety of outfits. It will single out a few to the participant and ask how they think it presents the character. There will be both positive and negative tick boxes for this multiple-choice question. The user can select as many of these descriptions as they see fit. I would then ask the participant's personal favourite, and a box to explain why.

The survey will also ask the participant's gender identity and sexual preference, to investigate if there is a correlation between the gender of the player, and their outfit preferences. To respect privacy, both of these questions will include a 'prefer not to say' answer.
